



- 1) The use of face mask will be mandatory in any indoor activity or when the distance between different Kvutzot cannot be guaranteed. During outdoor activities where each Kvutza is separated, the use of face mask will be optional. This measure applies to anyone, regardless of their vaccination status.
- 2) Most of the activities will take place outdoors. Indoor activities will be allowed only in stable groups (Kvutzot).
- 3) In all the dynamics that allow it, we will try to maintain the distance between participants, however, due to the nature of our activities, this cannot be a mandatory measure.
- 4) The activities will be carried out in stable groups, determined by the generation or Kvutza of each participant, taking care at all times that interaction between Kvutzot happens only within the same Shijva or program (Mini Maccabi, Yonathan, Yehuda, Shimon and Aluma).
- 5) Hand washing protocols will be enforced during activities, especially before and after lunch time.
- 6) All participants and Staff must carry out a self-assessment and be aware of any symptoms of Covid-19 that they may present. Please report immediately in case of suspicion and refrain from participating in activities if that is the case.
- 7) All Staff members and Madrijchim must be fully vaccinated to attend the activities, likewise, all adults attending must be fully vaccinated or present a negative laboratory test taken the week before the activity.
- 8) Any participant or Staff who has traveled outside the state of California will not be able to participate in the activities until 10 days after their return, unless they present a negative PCR test taken 3-5 days after their arrival, which will allow them to return to activities after 7 days. For fully vaccinated participants, the quarantine period does not apply.
- 9) The quarantine and isolation periods will be determined based on the latest version of the *K-12 Schools Decision Tree* and will depend on each case.
- 10) Any Covid-19 positive case (verified or assumed) must be immediately isolated and reported to the Covid-19 Committee(covid@kenjc.org) for follow-up.
